### Special Needs Awareness Program

The purpose of the Special Needs Awareness Program (SNAP) is to provide for the safe evacuation of people with special needs. Special needs may be individuals with walkers, wheelchairs, oxygen, hearing/sight impairments, etc. The Special Needs Form may be submitted to the Fire Department at 797 Birch Street, Paradise, CA 95969; or to the Town Clerk Department, 5555 Skyway, Room 3, Paradise, CA 95969 by the clients themselves or by their home health care provider.

A "mail-in" postcard is available at either the Fire Department or the Town Clerk Department. The form is transmitted to the Logistics Section of the Emergency Operations Center which keeps an updated list for use during emergency situations. The clients are categorized into rescue "zones" according to where they live.
