

### **Requirements for Free Chipper Program:**

1. Brush or small trees must be within ten feet of a road or driveway in order to provide easy access for the commercial chipper and tow vehicle.
2. The brush must be piled with the butt end pointed toward the road or driveway in single rows, 2 – 4' in height.
3. The piles must not contain dirt or other debris
4. Preferable, the material will have been cut two (2) weeks prior to the date scheduled to be chipped
5. A priority will be given to areas that have a very high Wildland fire threat
6. There must be a place for the chipped material to be piled at the site. The chips are ejected from an outlet pipe, and depending on the amount of material, will form a pile of chipped material.
7. The chipper cannot block a public roadway.
