

HAZARD ABATEMENT

One of our frequently asked questions relates to how to prevent fire hazards around your home.

Pursuant to California Government Code 5175 and California Health and Safety Code 13108.5, the entire Town is declared to be a very high fire hazard severity zone. Since we do live in such a high threat area be sure to do the following:

- Cut and remove all grasses to a height of three (3) inches for at least 100' or to your property line.
- Thin the majority of native brush to create small groupings of two to three plants at least ten (10) feet apart for at least 100' or to your property line.
- Remove tree limbs that are within eight (8) feet of the ground, or within ten (10) feet of a chimney or stovepipe.
- Clean roof and gutters of leaves, pine needles or other dead debris.
- Provide a ten (10) foot clearance around any propane tanks.
- Keep the area within thirty (30) feet around your home clear of all dead vegetation.
- Remove all debris created by this clearing.
