**RESOLUTION #09-34**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE  
ACCEPTING SUPPLEMENT LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICE FUND  
(SLESF) (AB1584 COPS FRONTLINE)**

**WHEREAS**, AB1584 was signed into law in July, 1996, establishing Chapter 6.7 of the California Government Code (Sections 30061 through 30065); and

**WHEREAS**, Section 30061(c)(2), requires that the Town Council "...shall appropriate existing and anticipated moneys exclusively to fund front line municipal police service, in accordance with written requests submitted by the Chief of Police of that city..."; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 30061(c), the Town Council held a duly noticed public hearing at which the requests of the Paradise Police Chief for front line law enforcement needs for these funds were received and reviewed by the Town Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Paradise, as follows:

**Section I:** The Council does hereby accept the Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund (AB1584 COPS Frontline) in the estimated amount of \$100,000.

**Section II:** The Town Manager is authorized to execute any documents relating to the acceptance of the Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund.




