**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE,
CALIFORNIA, OF SUPPORT FOR THE BUTTE COUNTY TIGER GRANT FOR THE
SKYWAY WIDENING FROM SOUTH PARK DRIVE TO PENTZ ROAD**

WHEREAS, on December 15, 1998 the Butte County Board of Supervisors acting on the recommendations of the July 1996 Skyway Improvement Program Feasibility Study prepared by the Butte County Association of Governments directed the County Department of Public Works to proceed with a project study of the possible design alternatives to widen the Skyway from two lanes to four lanes between Pentz Road and South Park Drive; and

WHEREAS, the County of Butte wishes to seek grant funding for this project consistent with the terms of the Recovery Act "TIGER" program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Paradise as follows:

Section 1: The Town Council of the Town of Paradise supports the Butte County Tiger Grant for the Skyway widening from South Park Drive to Pentz Road.

Section 2: The Town Council of the Town of Paradise encourages Butte County to pursue appropriate growth management strategies for the upper Paradise Ridge area.






