ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

The Paradise Redevelopment Agency invites separate sealed bids for a public works project relating to construction of the Paradise Community Park Project. This project will involve the placement of curbs, gutters, asphalt, restroom/concession, storage building, sidewalks, storm drain, drop inlets, lighting and electrical bollard, signage, site furnishing, planting, irrigation, and the Depot Building Renovation/Restoration.

Bids will be received at the office of the Town Clerk/Agency Secretary, 5555 Skyway, Paradise, California, until 10:00am local time, Thursday, April 13, 2006, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Copies of the Contract Documents, excluding General Provisions and Standard Technical Specifications, may be obtained at the Office of the Town Engineer upon request, for a non-refundable fee of \$20.00. Please add an additional \$5.00 for mailing.

Copies of the referenced Standard Specifications issued by the State of California, Department of Transportation, may be obtained from the State of California, Department of Transportation, Publications Distribution Unit, 1900 Royal Oaks Drive, Sacramento, CA 95819.

Pursuant to Section 1770, and following, of the California Labor Code, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages to persons working on the project, as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of the prevailing wage determinations are on file in the Town Engineer's Office. The holidays upon which the holiday wage rate shall be paid shall be all holidays recognized in the collective bargaining agreement applicable to the particular craft, classification or type of workman employed on the project.

The Paradise Redevelopment Agency encourages the submission of bids and sub-bids by minority-owned and women-owned business enterprises. The attention of bidders is particularly directed to the provisions of Section 8-1.02 of the Standard Specifications regarding assignment of the contract.

Each bid shall be made in accordance with these Contract Documents, and no bid will be accepted by the Town unless it is made on the Proposal forms included in these Contract Documents. Each bid must be accompanied by cash, certified or cashier's check or Bidder's Bond made payable to the Paradise Redevelopment Agency for an amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid as a guarantee that the Contractor will execute the Contract in conformance with his Proposal and the Specifications. Such guarantee shall be forfeited should the bidder to whom the Contract is awarded fail to enter into the Contract.

The Contractor shall possess the appropriate class California contractors license or a combination of classes required by the categories and types of work included in this contract at the time the contract is awarded.

The Agency reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informality in any bid and to determine which bid, in the judgment of the Agency, is the lowest responsive bid and to make that award which is in the best interest of the Agency.
