
Permit must be on site when burning

What can be burned: Vegetative waste (leaves, limbs, pine needles) produced on the property for which this permit is issued.

What cannot be burned: *Any* non-vegetative waste products including, but not limited to: Garbage, paper products, demolition or construction materials or debris, petroleum waste, tires, plastics, cloth, et cetera.



Allowable burning with permit:

- Area within 10' of piles must be maintained free and clear of all flammable material and vegetation.
- Burn pile must be attended at all times by a responsible person until fire is completely extinguished.
- Do not burn unless weather conditions (particularly wind) are considered safe.
- A water hose that can readily apply adequate water to all parts of the burn site must be present.
- For open burning, the maximum pile size cannot exceed 6' in diameter (1 pile only).
- Burn barrels not allowed in the State of California.

When burning is allowed:

- With a valid permit. Obtained by submitting this completed and signed form with remittance of \$24.64 to Paradise Fire & Rescue at 767 Birch Street.
- In the Spring (March, April and May). See reverse. Burning occurs:
 East of Clark Rd - The 1st through the 15th
 West of Clark Road - The 16th through the 31st

- On burn days as determined by Butte County Air Quality Management District. Call **332-9407** for a *daily* status. Current information is available after 8:45am.
- From 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Fire/embers must be *completely* extinguished by 2:00 p.m.

This permit remains valid should the Fire Chief opt to open a burn period in the fall. Any allowable fall burn does not alternate burning between east and west sides. Updated information is available via recorded message 872-6264, press 1.
