EVACUATION WARNING LIFTED

The Town of Paradise is lifting the Evacuation Warning for Zone 14. Reduced but continuing fire activity on the west side of the Bear Fire will require residents to remain vigilant for changes.

There is still no fire in the Town of Paradise, no fire in Concow, and according to Cal Fire there is no current threat to the Town of Paradise.

PG&E has restored all power to the Town of Paradise and all traffic signals are operating normally. Please continue to drive cautiously due to the smokey conditions.
