ORDINANCE NO. 537

AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 10.38 TO
THE PARADISE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO
PEDESTRIANS USING CROSSWALKS

The Town Council of the Town of Paradise, State of California does **ordain as follows**:

SECTION 1: Chapter 10.38 is hereby added to the Paradise Municipal Code to read as follows:

CHAPTER 10.38
PEDESTRIANS

Sections:

10.38.010 Use of Crosswalks

10.38.010. Use of crosswalks. It shall be unlawful for a pedestrian to cross a street in any location other than a marked crosswalk within the following public street segments, identified below:

1. Pearson Road between Mallan Lane and Clark Road
2. Skyway between Black Olive Drive and Center Street

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, this ordinance shall be published with the names of the members of the Town Council voting for and against it in a newspaper of general circulation published in the Town of Paradise, California.




