Town of Paradise Public Works and Butte County Sherriff's Fire-Safe Work Crew set to begin Fire Fuels Reduction Partnership

Starting Monday, July 13, Town of Paradise Public Works and Butte County Sherriff's Fire-Safe Work Crew will begin a fire-fuels reduction project. Crews will be working together to ensure Pearson Road between Pentz Road and Clark Road is a clear and open fire break. This primary evacuation corridor has become largely overgrown from trees, shrubs and brush in recent years. Clearing efforts will be within the Town right of way and will include major pruning on established trees, removal of overhanging limbs, and removal of other potential fire fuels. Paradise residents can expect traffic control impacts along Pearson Road in areas between Pentz Road and Clark Road, including one-way reversible traffic control. Minor delays should be expected on the roadway for the next two to three weeks.
