**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF PARADISE
AUTHORIZING THE 30-DAY SUSPENSION OF DOG LICENSE LATE PENALTY FEES
AS ASSESSED WITHIN THE SCHEDULE OF FEES IN RESOLUTION NO. 09-48**

WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise has adopted Resolution No. 09-48 establishing the schedule of fees for Town services relating to the Town costs directly associated with the services rendered by the Town; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 09-48, Exhibit A, Section 2, sets forth the fees associated with the dog license late penalty for animal control operations for renewing an expired Town of Paradise dog license; and

WHEREAS, the primary mission of animal control operations is to control the spread of rabies within the Town of Paradise through the pet licensing program, vaccination clinics and public education programs; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to improve dog licensing compliance within the Town of Paradise by way of public education, enforcement and incentives.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE as follows:

Section 1. The Town Council hereby authorizes a 30-day suspension from date of this resolution of the late penalty fees for Town of Paradise dog licenses as established by Resolution No. 09-48, Exhibit A, Section 2.

Section 2. The suspension of Resolution No. 09-48, Exhibit A, Section 2 shall terminate at 5:00 p.m. on the 30th day after the date of this resolution.
