- PG&E applications require you to upload site plans

5. Building Inspectors and Staff – Findings and Q & A

- What they're seeing in the field, how that can help you get though inspections faster
- Plan Review 3-week turnaround time. Issues noticed, problems with septic on site plan.
- Surveys are required. Some issues noticed, missing survey pins. Please let PG&E, BRC inspectors, or road crews know to have missing pins reset.
- Inspectors' correction notices, make sure all items are checked off on inspection checklist before re-inspection. Make sure the Calcerts HERS, or CHEERS, PID letter, and WMP Recycling forms are ready and turned in on or before the day of your final. Checklists are available for everyone on www.townofparadise.com/building/page/inspections-checklists
- Changes on Masterplans have to go through a revision process prior to revision in the field.
- Sitting Logs & Brush piles must be removed. Burn season is currently open Burn times: 600 am dusk, you can only burn vegetation
- BMP's wattles to hold the dirt and sediment onto the site, keeping mud out the street. Cover wattles, silk fences with plastic from rainwater for erosion control
- Please pay attention to your Title 24 Energy Calcs, having things calculated that aren't present in the home will cause you to have to re-submit either plans or Energy Calculation causing a delay in your final.
- Pay attention to your septic as you go, so it isn't un-finaled on the day of your inspection. Keep in touch with the Septic department to see where it is in the process of your home finalizing and to make sure there isn't anything holding up your Certificate of Occupancy. We want your process to be smooth and easy.
