



# TOWN OF PARADISE EVACUATION GUIDE READY. SET. GO.

Wildfires and other emergencies may require immediate evacuation.

**Prepare now, know your zone** and **leave early** when directed or if you feel threatened.

## KNOW THE TERMS



### EVACUATION WARNING

Potential threat to life and property.

Residents needing additional time should leave now.

**BE PREPARED.**



### EVACUATION ORDER

Immediate danger to life.

Leave immediately,

**LEAVE NOW.**



### SHELTER IN PLACE

Stay at your current location because evacuating may be more dangerous.

**STAY INFORMED.**

### KNOW MULTIPLE EVACUATION ROUTES

Review your enclosed evacuation map.



### KEEP VEHICLES FUELED AND READY

Don't let your tank go below half.



### PREPARE A GO BAG FOR EACH FAMILY MEMBER

See the Six "P's" to the right.



### PLAN FOR PETS AND LIVESTOCK

### KNOW YOUR EVACUATION ZONE

Check your zone on the enclosed map.

## THE SIX "P's"



### PEOPLE & PETS

Don't forget anyone.



### PAPERS & IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS

IDs, insurance, deeds, etc.



### PRESCRIPTIONS & GLASSES

Medications, vitamins, eyeglasses.



### PHOTOS & MEMORABILIA

Irreplaceable items.



### PHONES & CHARGERS

Keep devices charged.



### PLASTIC (CREDIT CARDS/CASH)

ATM cards, credit cards, cash.

# WHEN IT'S TIME TO LEAVE

Leave early. Do not wait if you feel unsafe or threatened.



## BEFORE YOU GO



Wear sturdy clothing and shoes



Load your Go Bag



Close windows and doors



Shut off gas if instructed



Leave exterior lights on



Take pets immediately

## DURING EVACUATION



Follow directions from law enforcement.



Traffic patterns may change during emergencies.



Do not stop along evacuation routes.



Stay with your vehicle unless directed otherwise.



You may be directed to a Temporary Refuge Area.

## IF YOU BECOME TRAPPED



### IN A VEHICLE

- Park in a clear area
- Close windows and vents
- Cover yourself with a blanket or jacket
- Turn off engine
- Remain inside your vehicle
- Call 911 with your location
- Signal for help if possible



### IN A BUILDING

- Stay inside
- Keep doors and windows closed
- Stay away from windows
- Move to an interior room, away from outside walls
- Do not go to the attic
- Signal for help if possible
- Call 911 with your address

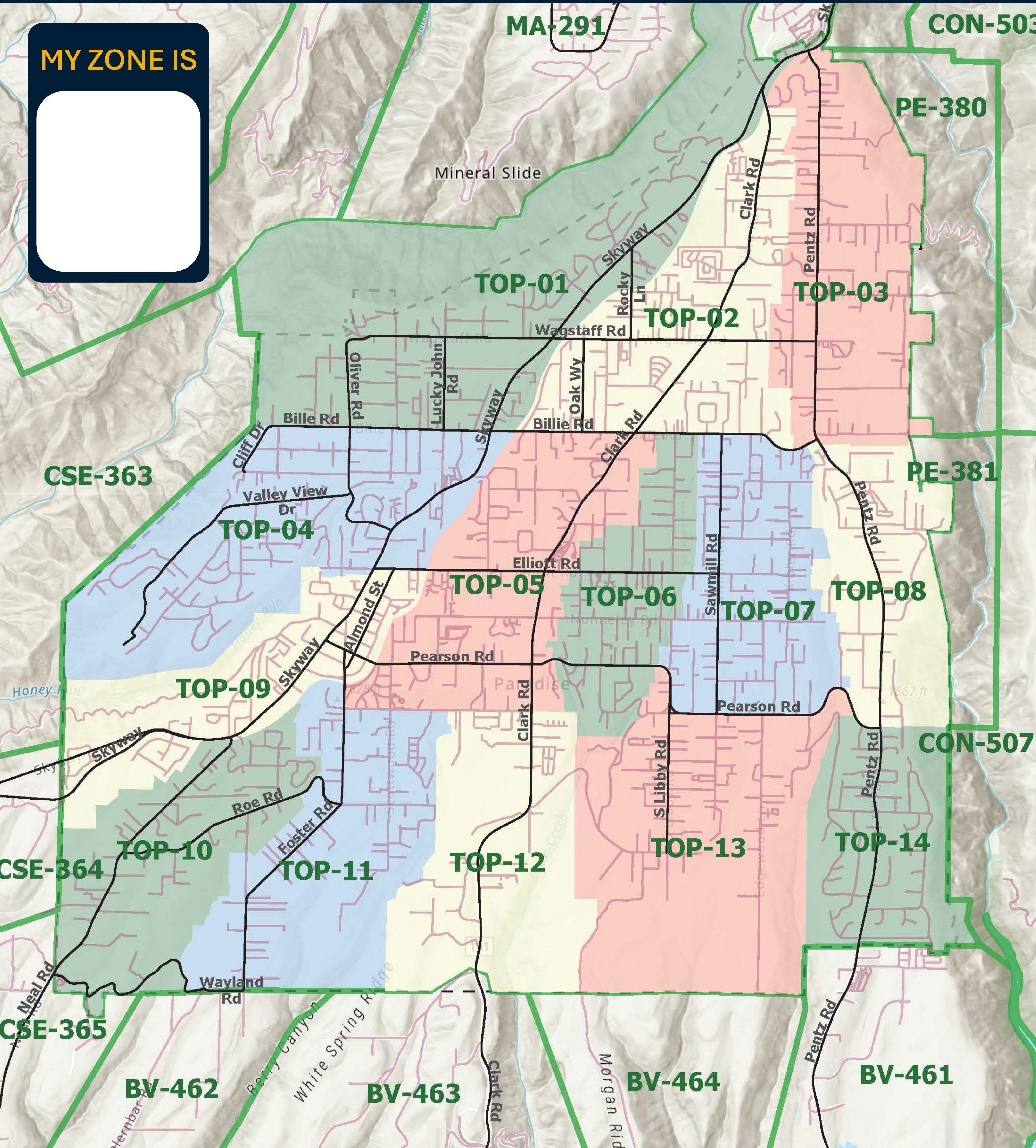
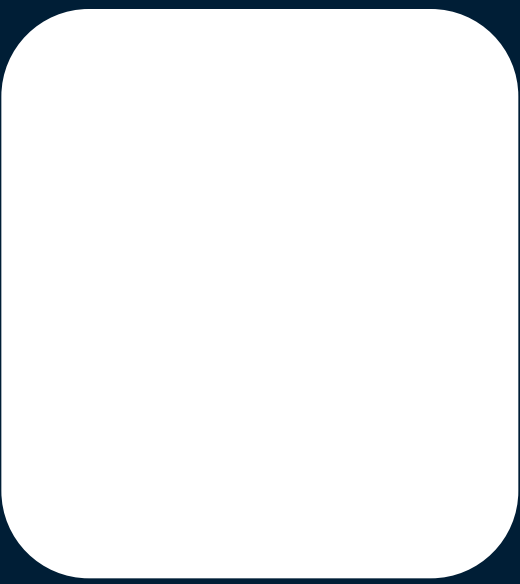

# CRITICAL RESOURCES

## STAY CONNECTED AND LEARN MORE.



**Butte County Community Evacuation Maps** provide live evacuation zone and route information for Paradise, Magalia, and surrounding areas. Scan the QR code to the left to view the interactive evacuation map and identify your zone before an emergency occurs. Maps also available at <https://www.buttecounty.net/>



**Smart911** provides official emergency notifications for Paradise and Butte County by text message, phone call, and email. Residents can register to receive evacuation warnings, emergency alerts, and critical incident information during wildfires and other emergencies. Visit <https://www.smart911.com/> to register and manage your emergency alert preferences.



**Free In-Home Emergency Warning Sirens** are available to Town of Paradise residents through a FEMA/Cal OES Hazard Mitigation Grant. The devices plug into a standard wall outlet and provide audible and visual alerts when the Town's network of emergency warning sirens are activated. A limited number of units are available on a first come, first served basis while supplies last. Units may be picked up at Paradise Town Hall, 5555 Skyway, during normal business hours. Available only to residents within Town limits.



**ALERTCalifornia** provides live wildfire camera feeds and real-time situational awareness tools used throughout California to monitor wildfire activity, smoke conditions, and other hazards. View live cameras and wildfire conditions at [ALERTCalifornia.org](https://ALERTCalifornia.org).



**Watch Duty** provides real-time wildfire alerts and incident information monitored by trained professionals, including firefighters, dispatchers, and first responders. Stay informed with up-to-date evacuation notices, fire activity, and emergency updates throughout California. Available on the Apple App Store and Google Play Store or <https://app.watchduty.org/>



**Official Social Media Accounts** provide timely emergency information, evacuation updates, road closures, firefighting activity, and other official incident information during wildfires and emergencies.
