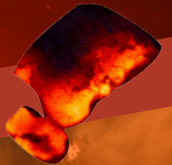

GETTING STARTED

1. Confirm Eligibility & Take Required Actions

Visit our website and answer two simple questions to see if your home is eligible. Then prepare your home using the Homeowner Guide, which takes you through the actions required to achieve a designation.

2. Apply for a Designation

Take our free assessment to ensure you've addressed program requirements. Next, apply for a designation and pay for an inspection.

3. Get an Inspection

A third-party inspector will visit your home to verify and document that program requirements have been met and to determine which designation you may qualify for—Wildfire Prepared Home or Wildfire Prepared Home Plus.

4. Achieve Designation

A team of wildfire experts will review the documentation and issue a designation.

Maintain Your Home's Designation

5. Submit Annual Landscape Review

Each year, you'll provide documentation to verify the required ongoing maintenance of your property.

6. Apply for Re-designation

Designations must be renewed every 3 years. A new physical inspection will be completed to ensure the home continues to meet program requirements.
